WHEREAS the price of electricity in Ontario has escalated to the level where this essential utility has become almost a luxury for many;

AND WHEREAS this has resulted in Hospitals, Schools, Municipalities, Businesses, Farms and Industries being faced with unbudgeted and unanticipated increases in costs for this essential utility and forcing many residential users to actually ration the use of electricity;

AND WHEREAS here in Temiskaming this has further resulted in valuable farmland being covered in solar panels and denied the vital agricultural crops that it would provide because of the excessive prices paid for this "green energy" produced by these panels;

AND WHEREAS much of Temiskaming District has to pay the highest rate of delivery charge for this needed service because of the low population levels in many areas of the District;

AND WHEREAS we are forced to watch as our primary highways are burdened and prematurely fatigued with heavy transports carrying mine concentrates out of Ontario to Quebec so as to benefit from the much lower hydro rates in that Province;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of Chamberlain supports the Temiskaming Municipal Association who implores the Province of Ontario and the Minister of Energy, the Honourable Glen Thibeault, to reduce the rates of this very essential utility to a level that will once more be affordable and predictable for the aforementioned users;

AND FURTHER THAT this resolution will be forwarded to the TMA, MPP John Vanthof and to FONOM for support. —Carried

WHEREAS the province has implemented a ban on door-to-door sales for electricity and natural gas contracts by passing the Strengthening Consumer Protection and Electricity System Oversight Act, 2015;

AND WHEREAS Ontarians over the last twelve months continue to experience unsolicited, aggressive and misleading sales tactics at their door from companies seeking to sell home energy products, despite this provincial legislation;

AND WHEREAS the door to door agents acting on behalf of these companies misrepresent their purpose and/or identity, often posing as utility inspectors and government agents needing to gain access to the homes of Ontarians;

AND WHEREAS people across Ontario, and in particular vulnerable Wellington North residents, have been targeted by these door to door misrepresentations and misleading sales tactics;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Township of Wellington North move to:

- 1. Urge the Provincial Government to ball all door-to-door sales in the home services sector (more specifically the sale or lease of HVAC equipment, water heaters, water filtration systems and other related home energy products and services by door-to-door sales agents) as soon as possible;
- Forward a copy of this resolution to all municipalities in Ontario asking for support by passing a similar resolution and forwarding to their MPP;
- 3. Forward a copy of this resolution to MPP Ted Arnott and MPP Randy Pettapiece.
- 4. Forward a copy of this resolution to the Ontario Legislature.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Township of Chamberlain supports this initiative and agrees to forward a copy to the MPP's listed above as well as MPP John Vanthof. -Carried
